Did Not Attend (DNA):

A “Did Not Attend” (DNA) – is simply a wasted appointment slot whereby a patient books an appointment, in some cases this can be a double or triple appointment, then for whatever reason doesn’t attend or cancel the appointment. Since we introduced the *interactive* text messaging service we are delighted to note that our wasted DNA appointments have dropped from an average of 140 per month to 67 in February.
