Saturday Morning Opening

We are pleased to announce that from 3rd October we will be offering appointments on Saturday mornings. The surgery will be open every other Saturday from 9:00am – 12:00 Noon. All the appointments will be pre-bookable in advance. Unfortunately, we will not be able to book any urgent appointments on the day or make any home visits. The regular Out Of Hours Doctor Service will be available as usual and for anything that cannot wait until the Surgery re-opens should be directed to the usual way to the 111 service.

This service is for fully registered patients of the surgery only.

The reason for this initiative is that although the Partners and the Patient Participation Group are working hard to meet our patients' needs we feel more can be done. We are particularly concerned about patients who find it hard to access the surgery during normal surgery hours and therefore are seldom seen. We would like to stress our regular Monday - Friday "urgent for the day" service remains unchanged and all registered patients are welcome to book Saturday morning appointments.

Complaints and Praise

We are always seeking feedback from our patients and looking for ways to improve our service.

Many of you will be aware of the Friends and Family Test we are running. This test asks one simple question, "Would you recommend this Surgery to your friends or family". So far we are pleased to report 99% of the responses we have received would either be "Extremely Likely" or "Likely" to recommend our surgery.

Praise: We were very pleased to receive 2 compliments via the NHS Choices website, which we have shared with all the staff with the Surgery.

Complaints: We have received one complaint this month which we are investigating – All Learning Outcomes will be shared with the staff.

Changes to the waiting room - Update

We had been considering two options:

- Convert the children's waiting area into an admin room for the Practice Manger, Deputy Practice Manager and Accounts Clerk.
- 2) Convert the main waiting room into an office by inserting a new wall. This option would also improve the confidentiality issues we have at present regarding the serving window.

Either plan would create a much needed extra consulting room and additional storage space for medical notes

We have decided that converting the play area would be the best option and be the least disruptive to the surgery.

The next phase will be to arrange for the new telephone extensions to be fitted and then the alterations can commence.

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Patient Participation Group

The Patient Participation Group is open to all fully registered patients of the practice and staff.

At present Dr. Whooley and Karen Greaves the Practice Manager are the Surgery representatives and attend all the meetings.

The current group meets on a monthly basis and the meetings are held in an informal way here at the Surgery.

At present the group is working on the patient satisfaction questionnaire for 2015, which is being led by Deborah Bland.

We have received a total of 73 responses to date but the figure is still rising. Once we are sure all the questionnaires have been returned we will publish the results.

The PPG will be running a cake stall to raise funds for the additional medical equipment the surgery will need after the refit.

The stall will be held in the Surgery on the 21th September from 10:00a.m - 12 Noon. All are welcome.

The next meeting of the PPG is here at the Surgery on the 22nd September 2015 at 7:00pm.

Although, there will always be a few unforeseen circumstances whereby it is impossible to cancel an appointment in advance the majority of the 139 appointments lost in August could have been re-used!


To assist patients we do have a dedicated cancellation answer machine service available 24 hours a day. To leave a message on the answer machine please call 01279 814730 and follow the prompts.
